### Dear Prospective Exhibitors for SEDHYD 2023:

You are cordially invited to reserve exhibit space at SEDHYD 2023, the Federal Interagency Sedimentation and Hydrologic Modeling Conference, May 8-12, 2023, in St. Louis, MO. Sponsorship opportunities are also available that recognize your organization and include exhibit space at the conference.

The highly regarded SEDHYD conference series began in 1947. This conference brings together engineers and scientists from government agencies, universities, and consultants with a focus on watersheds, stream channels, reservoirs, and related infrastructure. The SEDHYD conference is held every 4 to 5 years and is truly a magnet for experts and leaders in these fields. The theme for SEDHYD-2023 is Hydrology and Sediment Science for Resilient Systems in a Changing World (<https://www.sedhyd.org>). Based on past conferences, 400 to 500 engineers and scientists are expected to attend.

The exhibitor registration for SEDHYD-2023 is \$2,000 and includes one 10 ft x 10 ft booth and conference registration for two people. Please let me know if you are interested in providing an exhibit at SEDHYD-2023. I will send follow-up email with a web link to the registration site once it is operational.

We encourage you to exhibit at SEDHYD 2023 where you can meet and interact with professionals who oversee, design, award, and implement research and operational programs for hydrology, water quality, sedimentation, and hydrologic modeling.

- Exhibitor registration is \$2,000 and includes one 10-ft x 10-ft exhibit booth and full SEDHYD Conference Registration for two people. Each booth space includes a draped background 8-ft high with 3-ft high side drapes, one 6-ft skirted table, two chairs, one wastebasket, and a two-line booth I.D. sign.
- Additional full SEDHYD Conference Registrations may be purchased for \$700 (registering on or before April 3, 2023) or \$800 (registering after April 3, 2023). Exhibitor guests also can register for single days or events (costs vary) through the registration site.

- The Exhibit Hall is an excellent facility and is centrally located for the conference.
- Booth set-up can begin at Noon on Monday, May 8, 2023, and must be complete by 4:00pm.
- A Grand Opening of the Exhibit Hall on Monday includes a get-acquainted reception from 5:30pm to 7:30pm.
- A special Exhibitor's Reception is planned for Tuesday evening following the Technical Sessions.
- The Exhibit Hall will be open Tuesday (8:30am-6:45pm) and Wednesday (8:30am-3:30pm) for all coffee breaks and receptions held in the Exhibit Hall to ensure that participants have ample time to visit all the exhibits.
- Exhibits will close around 3:30pm on Wednesday, May 10, 2023.
