GUIDELINES FOR OUTSTANDING STUDENT PAPERS COMPETITION

Details:

- Three papers will be selected for the outstanding student paper award. Student authors from the three winning papers will receive \$600 (shared among student authors of that paper).

Eligibility:

- Open to current students, and students who graduate as recently as Winter 2022 or Spring 2023.
- Students must be the first author of the paper.

Evaluation Methods:

- Three judges will review each paper using the following rubric and evaluation criteria.

Component	Rating
Is the paper applicable and useful to the profession?	
Does the paper present research results that advance scientific understanding and/or methods within the field of study?	
Do the title and abstract accurately describe the contents? Does the abstract include all the main findings of the study?	
Is the methodology sufficiently well explained so that someone else knowledgeable about the field could repeat the study?	
Are the results soundly interpreted and related to existing knowledge on the topic?	
Is the paper well written? (e.g., sentences are varied, complex, and employed for effect. Diction is precise, and appropriate, using advanced vocabulary. Tone is mature, consistent, and suitable for topic and audience)	
The rating scale is from 1-5 based on the following definitions: 1 Poor, 2 Below average paper/not worthy of an award, 3 Average paper; possibly, but not likely, of award caliber, 4 Above average/possible award quality, 5 Exceptional/award quality.
